- Reporting an off-the-job injury as an on-thejob accident.
- Reporting an accident that never happened.
- Complaints of accident injury symptoms
- Not reporting outside income from other work-related activities while drawing workers' compensation benefits from another employer.
- Making false or fraudulent statements

that are exaggerated or non-existent to obtain increased or continued benefits.

- Malingering to avoid work when injury is healed.
- Physicians billing for services not rendered.
